



## **Angubolkul Education Scholarship**

The Department of Education seeks to award an Angubolkul Education Scholarship. Candidates will have an offer of admission to the University of Oxford University for the MSc Education all pathways (Comparative and International Education, Child Development and Education, Digital and Social Change, Higher Education, or Research Design and Methodology) for the academic year 2021/22. The scholarship is open only to candidates who are citizens of Thailand.

The value of the award will be up to £2,420. The award is made for the full duration of the period of fee liability for the agreed course, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made.

Applicants must apply to the University of Oxford for admission to the MSc Education (all pathways) on or before 22 January 2021. No separate application is required to be considered for this award. The applications of all eligible candidates will be automatically considered on the basis of the University application form for graduate study, and the award will be based on academic merit.

## **Terms and Conditions**

### **1. Satisfying the University's conditions**

This scholarship offer is conditional upon the student entering into an agreement with the University by signing the University student contract, which will be provided once the student has met all Department and College conditions.

### **2. Transferring between courses**

The scholarship may only be held by a student studying for the MSc Education on any of its pathways (Comparative and International Education, Child Development and Education, Digital and Social Change, Higher Education, or Research Design and Methodology). If the recipient transfers to another course, they may not be permitted to retain this award.

### **3. Deferral of entry**

Deferral of the scholarship is not normally possible.

### **4. Additional offers of funding**

The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships. The value of the scholarship can be reduced, if necessary, to allow it to be held in conjunction with other awards, providing that the combined value of the scholarship and other awards does not exceed the cost of fees plus living expenses equivalent to the RCUK minimum stipend. The student must inform the department of any other sources of funding, and the department reserves the right to adjust the value of the scholarship to account for this circumstance.

### **5. Satisfactory academic progress**

The student is expected to make satisfactory academic progress for the duration of their studies. If the student is not, in the Department of Education's opinion, making satisfactory academic progress, the Department will coordinate a review to decide whether the scholarship should be continued. The scholarship may be withdrawn in these circumstances.

### **6. Part Time Students**

This award is open to both full-time and part-time students. In the event that the award is made to a part-time student, the amount of the award will be divided evenly over two years.

### **7. Changes to circumstances**

In the event that your circumstances change or are likely to change in the future, you are asked to inform [msc.education@education.ox.ac.uk](mailto:msc.education@education.ox.ac.uk). The scholarship will be withdrawn if you cease to be a student member of the University.
